Title: Literacy tutor

Required qualifications: Applicants must be between 14 and 30 years of age.

Desired qualifications: Experience working with children. Knowledge of literacy training and techniques. Applicants enrolled in school full time at the time of application and/or who intend to pursue a career in education are preferred. Knowledge of the French language would be an asset.

Primary duties:

1. Provide one-on-one tutoring in basic literacy skills for up to 15 students in JK-Gr.6 over the school year.
2. Attend training in September to develop tutoring skills.
3. Assess child's literacy ability at beginning of session to tailor tutoring accordingly.
4. Give parents guidance to help them develop their child's literacy skills.
