Title: Literacy tutor

Hours: 35 hours per week, 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Monday-Friday, July 2-August 23, 2019

Wage: \$14.00/hour

Required qualifications: Applicants must be between 14 and 30 years of age. Applicants must be enrolled in school full time at the time of application and/or intend to enrol full time in the fall.

Desired qualifications: Experience working with children. Knowledge of literacy training and techniques. Coursework in education or a child services field.

Primary duties:

1. Provide one-on-one tutoring in basic literacy skills for up to 20 students over the course of the summer
2. Attend training sessions in June 2019 to develop tutoring skills. Some tutors may also be hired for the month of June for planning purposes
3. Evaluate program participants at beginning and end of each session
4. Understand and explain guidelines of Summer Reading Club to participants
5. Give parents guidance to help them develop their child's literacy skills
6. Some literacy tutors spend part of their day leading children's programming
7. Other tasks as assigned
